## Legislators to Attend Israel Trade Office Opening in Tel Aviv

**STATE CAPITOL, PHOENIX** – Representative Tony Rivero (R-21), chairman of the House State and International Affairs Committee, along with other elected members of the Arizona Legislature and the Arizona Israel Technology Alliance will celebrate the Israel Trade Office opening in Tel Aviv.

**“It’s an honor to celebrate the historic opening of the Arizona Trade Office in Israel with those who worked together with me to make this a reality,”** said Representative Rivero. **“By working together with Israel, we will strengthen trade and spur economic development. First, I would like to thank the Arizona Israel Technology Alliance for collaborating with the House State and International Affairs Committee and for making this trade visit a success.
