House Republicans Introduce Legislation to Help Reopen Arizona

STATE CAPITOL, PHOENIX – House Majority Leader Warren Petersen (R-12) announced the introduction today of legislation, HB2912, aimed at strengthening confidence in business owners and consumers as our society and economy reopens. Representative John Kavanaugh (R-23) is the sponsor.

Majority Leader Petersen issued the following statement regarding the bill:

“Arizonans have shown they can responsibly slow the spread of the coronavirus. Now that the stay at home order has expired, people are going back to work and play. But they need assurances that they can do so without the heavy hand of government threatening their ability to provide for and educate their family. That’s why Representative Kavanaugh and Senator Eddie Farnsworth are introducing bills to make sure there is confidence for businesses to keep opening, people getting back to work and schools to open in the fall without the fear of dealing with frivolous lawsuits.”
