Whereas, Rush Limbaugh was the syndicated radio host of "The Rush Limbaugh Show," which premiered in 1988 and quickly became the highest-rated talk radio program, airing on nearly 600 stations, reaching over 40 million people each week; and

Whereas, Rush Hudson Limbaugh III was born in 1951 in Cape Girardeau, Missouri, where he developed his passion for broadcasting that eventually led to his enshrinement in the Radio Hall of Fame and the National Association of Broadcasters Hall of Fame; and

Whereas, Rush Limbaugh was an unapologetic and influential conservative thought leader who, for decades, promoted the exceptional principles and freedoms that gave rise to the greatest nation in the world, the United States of America; and

Whereas, Rush Limbaugh was acclaimed author, including two New York Times bestsellers, who helped raise and personally donate millions of dollars to charitable organizations, benefitting America's military veterans and first responders; and

Whereas, President Donald J. Trump awarded Rush Limbaugh the Presidential Medal of Freedom, the Nation's highest civilian honor, at the 2020 State of the Union Address; and

Whereas, Rush Limbaugh passed away on February 17, 2021, after a tough battle with cancer; and

Therefore, I, Representative David Cook, invite the Members of the House of Representatives to honor the life and legacy of Rush Limbaugh; and ask that you please join me in commending Rush Limbaugh for his devotion to our country and for inspiring millions to embrace conservative values and American principles.
