Majority Leader Toma Named “Legislator of the Year” by American Legislative Exchange Council

STATE CAPITOL, PHOENIX – House Republican Majority Leader Ben Toma has been selected by the American Legislative Exchange Council (ALEC) to receive its 2022 Legislator of the Year Award in recognition of his “tireless work to uphold the principles of limited government, free markets and federalism.”

Majority Leader Toma sponsored and led the successful effort this year to pass [HB 2853](#), which expanded eligibility for Arizona’s Empowerment Scholarship Account program to every family in Arizona, giving parents the freedom to choose the education that best fits their child’s needs. He also authored historic tax reform, including a 2.5% flat tax rate, passed by Republicans in 2021, which has provided Arizonans economic relief right when they need it most and helped to fuel the state’s job and business growth.

Toma will be presented with the award at ALEC’s Jefferson Awards Ceremony on November 30 in Washington, D.C..
