BORDER SECURITY

The number one priority for the House Republican Majority Caucus is to continue in our efforts to secure our border. Building on past investments, we plan to fund sheriffs and other law enforcement agents willing to crack down on our unsecure border. House Republicans also aim to preserve the mission of the Border Strikeforce and focus on the prevention of drug and human trafficking occurring at the border, especially as fentanyl continues to infiltrate and kill in our communities. Steadfast and continuous action will be the most effective way to resolve these issues. Should the feds refuse to act and protect our border, House Republicans *will* invoke our 10th Amendment sovereignty and take matters into our own hands.

ELECTION SECURITY

House Republicans recognize the necessity of ensuring that all of Arizona's elections are legitimate and one-hundred percent incorruptible. The newly formed House Committee on Municipal Oversight & Elections will work to identify real solutions to very real problems regarding our state's elections. Additionally, to protect our students and educators, House Republicans will support an opt-in grant program that can be used to teach faculty to spot warning signs, treat injuries, and learn how to rapidly respond to active threats.

House Republicans will support and prioritize funding to secure water for Arizona. Protecting our state's water resources will be crucial for our survival. Water resources must be allocated thoughtfully and appropriately to meet and represent all Arizonans' needs.
